Certificate for Quality of Internationalisation (CeQuInt) of ECA – Update on developments of the EU-project

13 pilot procedures at European Higher Education Institutions have been conducted

Within the framework of the EU-project ,Certificate for Quality of Internationalisation (CeQuInt)', which aims at promoting internationalisation in higher education and developing a robust framework for its assessment, 13 projects have been realised now. The findings of these procedures, which took place at institutional, faculty and programme level, are used to further develop the methodology.

As FIBAA has a long-term experience in working with internationally oriented higher education institutions and focusses on internationality in its accreditation procedures, it could contribute to the success of this project. The insights of the conducted procedures are also a clear benefit to FIBAA and its procedures for quality assurance and quality development in the field of higher education.

FIBAA conducted a pilot procedure at the University of Kassel

Within the pilot procedure at the University of Kassel, FIBAA recruited an international expert panel, which visited the International Center for Development and Decent Work (ICDD) on 16th of October. The reviewers assessed the interdisciplinary master programme in Global Political Economy with regard to its internationalisation concept. The site visit was characterised by lively and constructive debates among the reviewers and the representatives of the university on the strengths and further potential of the study programme.
